## **Programme:**

### ***Pre-Meeting tour to Graz (optional), Wednesday, November 17:***

*Graz is the capital of Styria, Austria's southernmost province, a city with unique Mediterranean flair.*

*Coming to Graz is the beginning of a new friendship. The old alleys and squares, impressive buildings, museums and galleries make you want to find out more about this city at the crossroads of cultures. Your Graz colleagues will take you on a fascinating theme tour of the historical centre. Discover the cultural and culinary delights of this captivating city!*

### **Wednesday, November 17:**

Arrival in Vienna, and transfer to Hotel Hilton Danube



### **Thursday, November 18: Classical Vienna**

Today your Viennese colleagues will take you on a full day sightseeing tour of "Classical Vienna" - from the medieval splendour of St. Stephen's Cathedral at the heart of Old Vienna, to the imperial Hofburg Palace, where Habsburg rulers resided for more than six centuries. The sightseeing starts with a panoramic coach tour around the historical Ring Street, which replaced the old town fortifications.

With its fascinating history and great wealth of historical buildings, Vienna is a place that is best explored by walking - and this is how we will discover the most important sights of the city, as well as some hidden gems and treasures off the beaten track. The walk will help us get a sense of the great diversity of art, music and imperial tradition that is still alive in the city.

Inside visits will include the Spanish Riding School, where the tradition of classical horse dressage comes to life, as well as some of Vienna's finest museums (Treasury Collection or Fine Arts Museum).

In the evening the Chamber of Commerce, where all Austrian tourist guides are members, will host an event at their headquarters.

A short presentation by the MU Vienna, a university specialising in tourism studies, will be followed by a welcome reception.

### **Friday, November 19: Modern Vienna**

Experience modern Vienna: from the shiny office towers of the new Donau City to the urban development areas not far from the old town. This tour provides exciting contrasts between historical and modern architecture and will offer a new perspective of the city.

In the afternoon, there is free time to visit one of the many charming Christmas markets in the old town area.

In the evening, the Mayor of Vienna invites us to the City Hall, one of Vienna's most beautiful buildings on the historical Ring Street, where the Gala Evening will be celebrated in the tradition of a Viennese ball. A gala dinner will be followed by "waltz for all". Viennese and Austrian colleagues and representatives from the local tourism industry will join us for an unforgettable night of dancing and entertainment.

This evening will be hosted by the Vienna Tourist Guide Association.



### **Saturday, November 20: Around Vienna**

Klosterneuburg Monastery rises from a hill not far from the banks of the Danube. The impressive complex houses countless treasures, as well as one of the largest wine cellars in Austria.

Afternoon at leisure.

We visit a traditional wine tavern in the Vienna Woods and experience the new wine, Viennese song and hospitality.

### **Sunday, November 21: Schoenbrunn Palace & Farewell**

The former summer residence of the Imperial family, a Cultural World Heritage Site, is one of the most beautiful palaces in Europe. It is also a place where famous artists and craftsmen from many different epochs created interiors of great beauty. All the rooms in the palace have their own stories to tell, stories on the margins of great historical events which are indicative of the lifestyle, atmosphere and world view of the imperial era.

After a special guided tour, it is time for our farewell reception, and time to say goodbye to Vienna.
