REGISTRATION

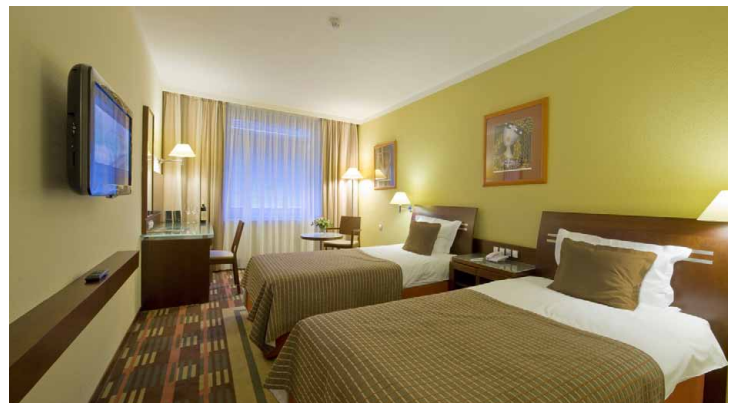
